- If they can't spare even 1-2 hours a day
- If they don't practice and communicate.

If a person relies only on textbooks and grammar, it will be difficult to reach the B2 level. But if you sincerely, with good intentions, give it your all, and focus only on it, you can achieve your goal. This certainly requires great perseverance from a person.

So, what is the role of training courses in this?

Books and movies: You should read and watch books and movies in English. This will improve your listening and speaking skills. It is more beneficial to start with subtitles and then try to watch them without them.

Learn from your mistakes: If you fail to achieve the level you want in IELTS or CEFR, you should not give up on studying. You should understand your mistakes, learn from them, and not repeat them. You should just keep moving forward.

Practical tips: Describe your daily study plan in detail. For example, study grammar from 7:00 to 8:00 in the morning, and do listening exercises in the afternoon.

Vocabulary building: Recommend apps and methods you can use to learn new words every day. For example, flashcard apps like Anki or Quizlet.

Use of technology: Online resources: It is necessary to watch English videos on YouTube, TED Talks and other platforms. Watching them with subtitles allows you to improve your listening and speaking skills.

Podcasts: Listening to English podcasts improves your listening skills. For example, podcasts like “The English We Speak” or “6 Minute English”.

Motivation and psychological tips: Goals and rewards: Setting small goals and rewarding yourself when you achieve them motivates you and makes the learning process interesting.

Language tests and evaluation: Checking your knowledge every week or month helps you monitor your progress and make the necessary changes. Mock Exams: Before the real exams, you can test your preparation by taking mock exams.

Group learning: Language exchange groups: One of the important things is to join language exchange groups. This gives the person the opportunity to use English in real life and helps them test their knowledge [4;54].

Five simple ways to learn a foreign language quickly:

There is rarely a person who is not impatient when learning a foreign language. You can learn a language by just saying “Kuf suf” or “Abraka-Dabra”. But it is not as easy as it seems, but at the same time it is not as difficult as it seems.

The most important aspect that ensures success in learning any foreign language is ability and desire. You should not be afraid of the issue of ability, because everyone has it. In 2006, American scientist Richard Sparks proved with his research that the idea that some kind of universal innate talent is needed to learn a language is unfounded. Now, as for desire. The wise saying "Desire is a thousand opportunities, and unwillingness is a thousand excuses" is very apt. Determine one thing: do you want to learn a language or not? If your desire is serious, the following tips will definitely help you.

Use dictionaries. Many linguists believe that learning a language with the help of dictionaries greatly improves the ability to remember individual words and phrases, as well as sentence structure. A person who learns a language through ready-made sentences in the first person does not just repeat sentences, but feels himself in certain situations. For example, while learning the phrases needed to make a purchase in a store, a person feels as if he is buying and selling. A study was conducted in a school specializing in in-depth teaching of English in Russia. Students remembered the part of the text in the first person by ninety-eight percent. This shows that learning a language with the help of dictionaries is very effective.

Work according to the rule. Experts have found a very effective way to master new words. Memorize 30 words a day, 5 of which should be verbs. Every day, you will sort the words in the dictionary alphabetically. For example, if today the first thirty words starting with the letter "A" are selected, tomorrow the thirty words starting with the letter "B" are selected. After going through the alphabet completely, the next thirty words starting with the letter "A" are memorized. This habit will gradually form into a system, and your memorization will become easier and easier. For this method to be effective, memorize words every day, and there should be no days off at all!

Learn poems and songs. One of the most enjoyable and effective methods is to learn foreign poems and songs along with their translations. There are many people who have learned English in three months using this method. Linguists say that this method is especially effective when the learner translates the poems and songs himself.

Understand the content. Psychologists who conduct research on the acquisition of foreign languages have drawn attention to one mistake that many people make: learners often try to fully understand the speaker's speech or a conversation on a dictaphone. In fact, you should strive to understand the general meaning, not to catch every sound. Try to learn the tone of the language, the repetitive words, and the sentence structure. Don't focus on the small details.

Conclusion. From this article, it should be concluded that if a person really wants, everything is within his power. It is possible to reach the B2 level from 0 in 6 months. To do this, you need to set a goal, study regularly, use modern technologies and use the language in real life. By implementing these methods, you can also achieve success in learning a language.
